esseri, ma senza dubbio una delle più originali è quella espressa in questo saggio da Massimo Conese, docente di Patologia generale della Scuola di medicina dell'Università di Foggia. Una tesi, in disaccordo con le teorie "simboliche" circa l'origine delle fate, che viene documentata con numerosissime fonti dell'epoca e testi moderni, una vasta bibliografia mitica, folklorica e medica e una serie di illustrazioni tratte da testi letterari e scientifici.
